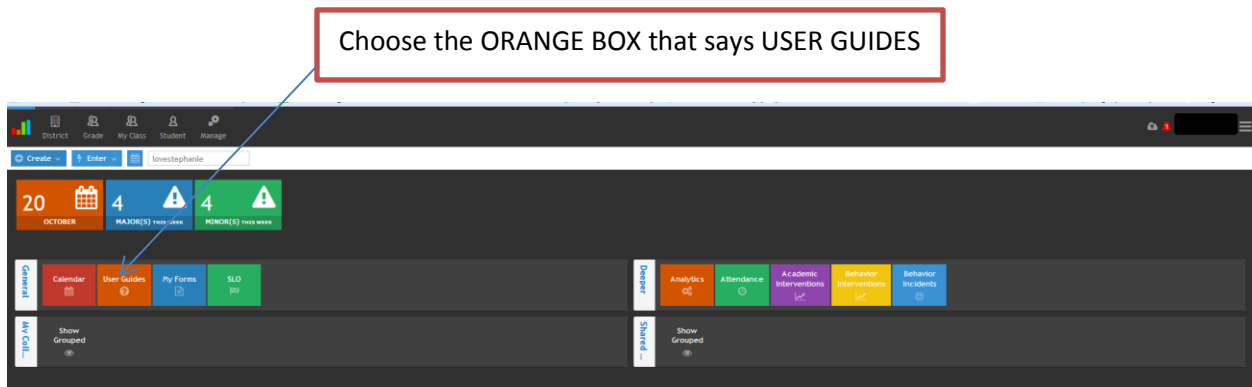
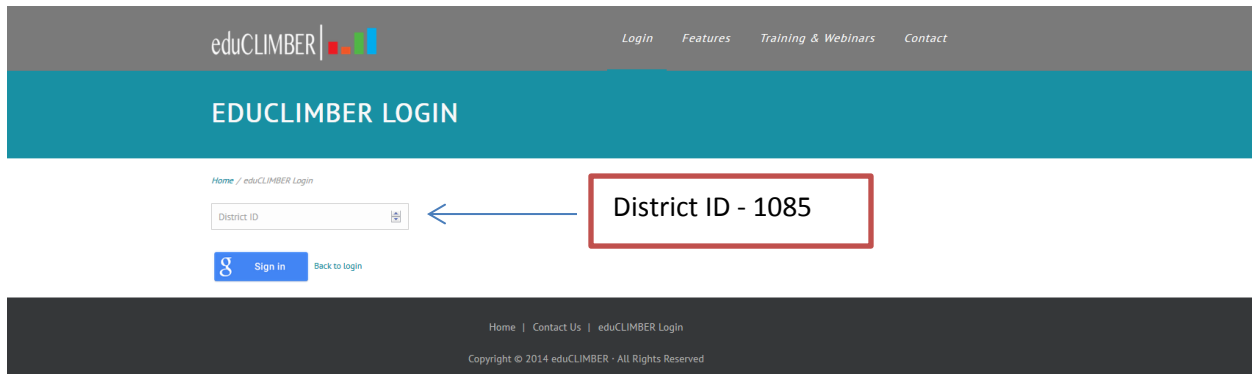
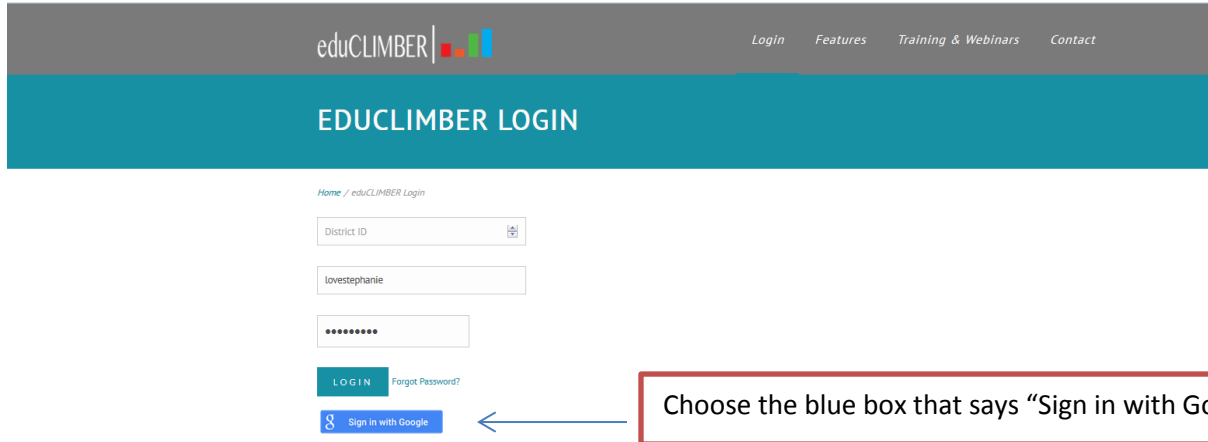

One quick tip...If you begin looking at data and don't see student names, but only see numbers, go to the quick menu on the top right of your dashboard (three horizontal lines), and "unclick" the Top Secret Mode.

Teachers have been given "grade level" access and should be able to see data on students assigned to them (their classes), and all students in those grades. Depending on job classification, you may have "building level" or "district level" access.
