

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM THE BOARD MEETING ON APRIL 4, 2016

- 1) The District is in the process of creating a Mental Health Action Team so that the community and the District can work together to help meet the mental health needs of our students. - 3) The Board approved a High School trip to Guatemala for Spring Break 2017.
- 4) The Board approved DECA students attending the DECA International Development Conference in Nashville, Tennessee, April 22 -27.
- 5) As part of the facility plan that Bray is working on for the District, the Board approved School Perceptions completing a survey to determine the facility need priorities of the community.

- 7) The Board approved the major budget items for 2016-17. Even though the District's revenue is not increasing by a large amount, we are able to add some important positions that directly impact our students such as a school psychologist at the High School, an additional section for the current year's 1st grade class for next year to keep the sections within our recommended guidelines, increased librarian time at the elementary level and some additional sections of science and social studies at the High School.
