

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM THE BOARD MEETING ON SEPTEMBER 21, 2015

- 1) Gary Albrecht, CESA 2 Administrator, and Nancy Thompson, President of WASB, recognized Jeff Hanna for his 11 years of service as a member of the CESA 2 Board of Control.
- 2) Scott DeYoung, Al Martin, Dave Martin, Bruce Ferrin, Gordy Brunner, Robert Tucker, Scott Strohmusch, and Randy Docken (as well as all of the other custodial staff members) were recognized for stepping up and taking on additional responsibilities late spring and early summer before Martin Russell was hired as the Building Services Coordinator.
- 3) The MHHS Marching Band has been asked to perform at the world famous New Year's Day parade on January 1, 2017. This invitation is bestowed on only the most elite programs. On Tuesday, September 15, we were honored to host the Senior Parade patron and past Lord Mayor of Westminster, Catherine Longworth, who not only officially invited the band to perform, she also gave several gifts including cufflinks for Director Janssen, a medal for the band president, and umbrellas.
