

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM
THE SEPTEMBER 8, 2015 BOARD MEETING

- 1) Request for Proposals for the High School HVAC project have gone out to potential contractors. An additional week was allowed to receive more accurate pricing. The proposals will be discussed and possibly acted on at the September 21 Board meeting.
- 2) The Board was presented a petition signed by 208 District residents calling for a Special District Meeting for the sole purpose of determining school board member compensation. The Board approved holding such a meeting. Once set, the Notice of the specific date and time will be published as required and included in the next update.
- 3) The Board approved a new policy (Policy #443.3) affecting student use and possession of tobacco products, related devices or electronic cigarettes. The policy was initially reviewed by the Safety and Wellness Committee. Please reference the policy for more information.
- 4) The Board earlier approved hiring a teacher to work with the students who had signed up for the Building Trades program on his own project which will enable the students to get a similar work experience as in the past. The district is moving in the direction of Science Technology Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) for the program in the future but strives to provide work experience programs for the students who are interested in the building trades areas.
- 5) The Board has created a new Community and Legislative Engagement Committee. I sent out a request earlier for volunteer community members to be on the committee. I did receive a couple of inquiries but I am asking again for possible interested volunteers. Specific meeting dates and times have not been set and will be decided once the group is formed, but it will probably be early evening to accommodate work schedules.
